We are looking forward to seeing all the amazing things Quinn does the rest of the CEO school year and in his future endeavors!

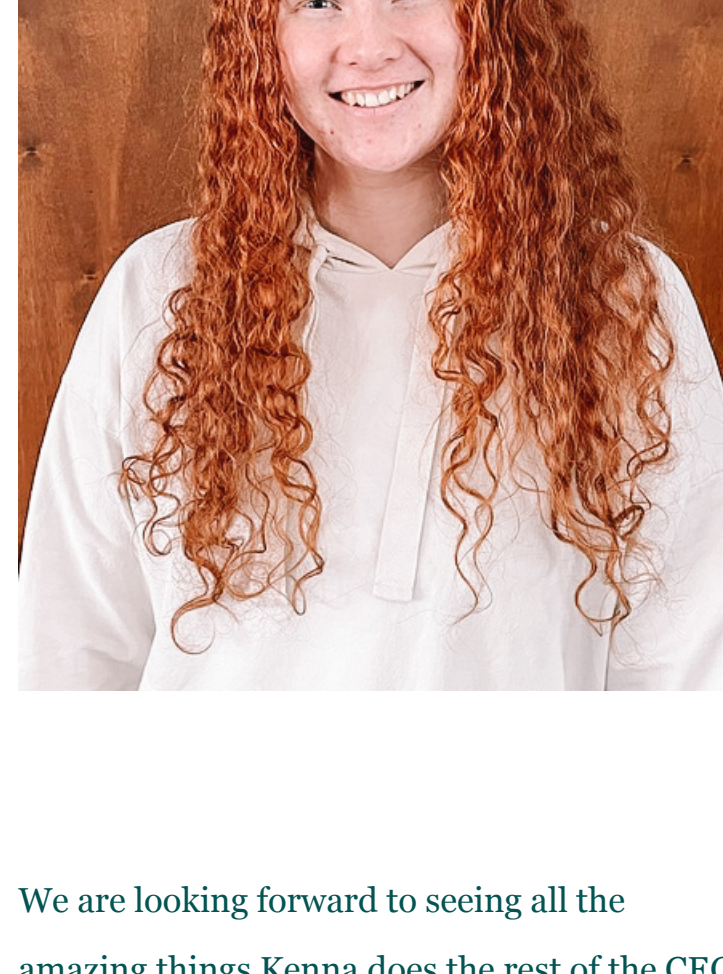
#### Meet Kenna

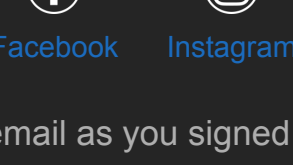
